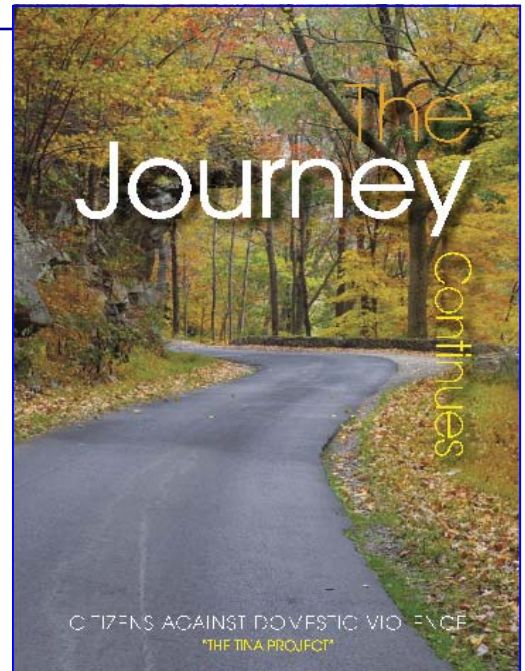
“The Tina Project”

Crouchers stay busy on the Road

Shortly after the passage of the “Tina Croucher Act” a coalition of 14 Northeast Ohio agencies who deal with domestic violence pulled together and formed “The Tina Project”. With the blessings of Jim and Elsa Croucher, the group named their organization in honor of Tina, and their mission is to assist schools in becoming compliant with HB19 by providing, among other things, in-service training to middle and high school employees on the topic of dating violence. Since the launch last year a number of other organizations around the state have joined in including Citizens Against Domestic Violence. In January of this year, CADV hosted a training workshop in Dayton, Ohio, which was attended by representatives from organizations in five surrounding counties. Tim Boehnlein, and “The Tina Project” partners in Cleveland have just hired a state coordinator who will be heading up this organization for the State.

Now in its 15th year, the Crouchers have reached over 100,000 students with their education and mission, “so that what happened to our daughter Tina never happens to another person (or teen)”. And just because school is out doesn’t mean the learning stops! The Crouchers will be presenting their program at the YWCA Girls Summer Camp in Dayton in July.
